- Ensure buyers are aware of the environmental, resource and carbon impacts of their purchasing decisions
- Prohibit the use of products or processes that are damaging to the environment or climate or where a better alternative exists
- Minimise energy consumption through the procurement of renewable energy sources where possible
- Identify procurement options that support circular economy and zero waste principles
- Work with suppliers to phase out non-recyclable packaging or packing materials
- Procure recycled and sustainably certified paper products

Social


- Implement a proactive approach to managing modern slavery risks within our supply chain
